# Artwork Exhibit Guidelines

## *Artist Participation:*

All art submissions **must include** the following:

- Type of mediums used,
- Title and monetary value
- Brief explanation (1-2 sentences) of the inspirational thought behind the art work
- Complete *Term & Conditions & Art Entry Form*

## *Artwork Eligibility:*

All artwork entries must be of “original nature” and not previously shown in the Princeville Heritage Days Fine Art Show & Exhibit

Open to Grade School age students, High School age students, and adults.

Eligible works may include: photography, watercolor, oil, pen & ink, pencil, acrylic, sculpture, pastels, mixed media, collage, printmaking, etc. Limits: 5 entries per person. Entries must be original and produced within the past two years.

Prohibited are velvet drawings, anything manufactured from a kit, or mass produced including craft items.

While we welcome a diverse selection of submissions, we reserve the right

to reject any submission we deem not suitable for public display. This will be determined at the time of submission or during the show.

## *Presentation of Artwork:*

Artwork will need to be display ready to be hung on peg boards. Framed pictures need the appropriate weight wire on back for hanging purposes.

Framed work must not exceed 36 inches on any side.

Any 2 dimensional artwork must be display ready (matted &/or framed and ready for hanging).

If artwork is abstract in nature, please indicate the “top” of the picture on the reverse side.

Any entry which has been reproduced from an existing photo, painting, graphic, advertisement or any other work produced by another person is a violation of the competition rules and **will not** be accepted.



Entries which do not conform to rules and goals of the exhibit will not be accepted.

*Please keep the material family oriented and appropriate for our general audiences.*

Although all caution will be taken, the Lillie M. Evans Library District and the Princeville Civic Association assumes no responsibility for the safety of work submitted. Insurance is the **exhibitor's responsibility**. Furthermore, the exhibitor shall indemnify the organization (LME Library) and hold this organizer harmless against all loss, damages, claims, and cost, including reasonable attorney fees, etc.
