- C. School Board remarks: They got a variance and bids for the storage unit at the District Office, but the bids were high. They are thinking of putting the storage unit back by the HS batting cage area now. One of the baseball fields lights was taken out by a windstorm. Trying to decide whether to replace all of them or just the one. The school did the Orange frog (Happiness Advantage) for their back to school program.
