- C. Introduction of School Board and Remarks – The Princeville #326 School District was called to order at 7:02 p.m. on July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Grant DeBord, Jeremy Duckworth, Darwin Stahl, Mike Harman, and Superintendent Tony Shinall were present. Darwin introduced their new Superintendent, Tony Shinall. This was his first board meeting and he has only been with the district seven days. Mr. Shinall said that the Princeville community has been very welcoming. The school system is top notch, and all was going well. The football field is good. Construction at the daycare is going well. Mike Harmon said that they were giving Mr. Shinall time to adjust to his job before having him talk more.
- D. Introduction of Library Board and Remarks – The Lillie M. Evans Library Board was called to order at 7:04 p.m. Diane Smith, Randy Ingle, Rachel Wilson, Angie Stahl, Gayle Johnson-Brackett, Director Beth Duttlinger, and Deb Givens were present. Beth passed out a list of some of the activities coming up at the library. The Music in the Park was attended by over 400 people. The book sale will be from 7/31 – 8/31. The tokens for summer reading have been a huge success and the kids can redeem their tokens from Princeville businesses. The library will start the Read Down Your Fines on August 1<sup>st</sup>. There are Maker Labs coming up for people to attend. The library was awarded \$20,000 in a grant to start a community garden. The grant will make it more accessible too. There will be interactive movie nights again starting in September. Story time and Toddler time will start when school starts.
- E. Introduction of Village Board and Remarks – The Village of Princeville Board was called to order at 7:09 p.m. Jeff Troutman via Google, Steve Potter, Richard Schoenbeck, Teresa Gilroy, Ron Delbridge, and Julie Delbridge were present. Jeff Troutman talked about the sewer update. The final plans will be at the end of the year. EPA needs to process the plan and that could take nine months. They hope to start bids in January of 2025. They hope to start construction in April of 2025. The Village is going to upgrade the water main on Santa Fe since they have another year until they will start on the sewer update. They are hoping for a revitalization of the Alcoa building. They should know more at the next meeting on that. Greenfield would like to purchase the ground by Dollar General to build a building for their company. Ron Delbridge said that they are just spray patching around town since it's too late to seal now.

Greg Down was hoping to talk to Mr. Thole to see if there were any high school kids who would like to be in the program with the fire department.
