Sprint Internet Service

The 4G LTE wireless broadband service offered by Sprint uses the same network as the 4G services offered by many telecommunications companies. Its download speeds average 6 to 8 megabits per second, with peak speeds of 25 megabits per second.

Instructions for use:

1. Hold the power key for 3 seconds to power the hotspot device on/off.
2. The LED indicators:
 - **Signal** displays your current network status.
Green light indicated good network connection; yellow light indicates poor network connection; red light indicates no network connection or service.
 - **Wi-Fi** indicates when Wi-Fi is connected.
 - **Battery** displays your current battery status.
When a solid red light indicates the battery level is less than 15%, please charge battery.
3. Open the wifi application or controls on your computer or wifi enabled device and find the wifi connection named **LMEhotspot#**
4. Connect to **LMEhotspot#** and when prompted, enter the password **Princeville**

Charging the battery:

A power adapter and charging cable are included in the box.

1. Plug one end of the charging cable into the power adapter and the other end into the hotspot.
 2. Now connect the power adapter to a standard AC wall outlet.
 3. The battery indicator will flash on the hotspot screen as the device charges.
- Do not use the included charging cable and power adapter with any other device.
 - Do not use anything but the included charging cable and power adapter to charge the hotspot.
 - The hotspot should only be plugged into the AC adapter while the device is charging. Once it is fully charged, unplug the hotspot to prevent overheating or device malfunction.

Instructions for use:

1. Hold the power key for 3 seconds to power the hotspot device on/off.
2. The LED indicators:
 - **Signal** displays your current network status.
Green light indicated good network connection; yellow light indicates poor network connection; red light indicates no network connection or service.
 - **Wi-Fi** indicates when Wi-Fi is connected.
 - **Battery** displays your current battery status.
When a solid red light indicates the battery level is less than 15%, please charge battery.
3. Open the wifi application or controls on your computer or wifi enabled device and find the wifi connection named **LMEhotspot#**
4. Connect to **LMEhotspot#** and when prompted, enter the password **Princeville**

Charging the battery:

A power adapter and charging cable are included in the box.

1. Plug one end of the charging cable into the power adapter and the other end into the hotspot.
 2. Now connect the power adapter to a standard AC wall outlet.
 3. The battery indicator will flash on the hotspot screen as the device charges.
- Do not use the included charging cable and power adapter with any other device.
 - Do not use anything but the included charging cable and power adapter to charge the hotspot.
 - The hotspot should only be plugged into the AC adapter while the device is charging. Once it is fully charged, unplug the hotspot to prevent overheating or device malfunction.
